Seamus Coffey was congratulated on his Ministerial appointment on 22 August as a Member of the Fiscal Council and as the Council Chairperson, effective 23 August, and warmly welcomed to the meeting.

Thanks were expressed to Michael McMahon who served as Acting Chairperson since 1 July 2023.

1. Pre-Endorsement

The Council prepared for the forthcoming endorsement discussion. The Council discussed the draft Budget 2025 forecasts received from the Department of Finance. As part of its decision-making process, it compared the Department's macroeconomic forecasts to the Council's Benchmark projections and other agencies forecasts; it

considered the methodology used to produce the forecasts; and it reviewed past forecast errors for evidence of systematic bias.

2. Department of Finance presents its forecasts

John McCarthy, Chief Economist/Assistant Secretary General and colleague(s) from Department of Finance's Economic and Budget Division joined the meeting and presented its draft Budget 2025 forecasts and responded to questions raised by the Council. The Council thanked the Department of Finance representatives who then left the meeting.

3. Council discussion on endorsement decision

The Council held further discussions related to the Department of Finance's forecasts in the context of a decision regarding endorsement. In this regard, the Council drafted the text for the endorsement letter which it agreed and approved.

The Council is satisfied that the final forecasts are within an endorsable range, taking into account the methodologies used and the plausibility of the judgements made. The Council endorsed as within the range of appropriate forecasts the set of macroeconomic projections prepared by the Department of Finance for Budget 2025 covering the years 2024 and 2025

The Council will discuss the endorsement process and assess the macroeconomic projections in its forthcoming FAR.

4. Flash Release for Budget Day

The Council discussed plans for its release of a visual summary of Budget 2025 shortly after the publication of the budget.

5. Upcoming Communications Plans

The timings of potential upcoming communication opportunities were discussed. The Council's Budget Flash Release will be published on budget day 1 October with the release forming the main media messaging and points of discussion. In addition, it is planned to finalise

the Infrastructure paper and Corporation Tax work for publication in the autumn. The new "Budgetary Resources" Calculator is currently being finalised with a view to having this online tool available to assist in framing discussion around the budgetary resources available over a defined period.

6. The Admin/Financial

 The Council approved the minutes of the meeting of the Council held on 2 August 2024. Stephen proposed and Adele seconded them.

Matters arising

It was noted that the 2023 Chairperson's Comprehensive Report and the 2023 Annual Report, to include the Audited Financial Statements, were submitted to the Department.

The Council agreed to appoint Michael McMahon as Vice-Chairperson to the Council effective 23 September 2024.

Thanks were expressed to Adele Bergin who served as Vice-Chairperson since 1 July 2023.
